When: March 4 - 23, 2019

Where: Orgyen Hermitage (Mary and Tarchin's home) on Windridge Lane, near Katikati.

Participants will need to have the maturity and resources to make arrangements for their own accommodation and meals. Possibilities might include: renting local cottages, camping, bringing your own self-contained camper-van, staying with local friends, or B&Bs. You will also need to arrange transport to the retreat and for shopping during the retreat.

This will be the first time we have tried to run such a long retreat at Orgyen and so in a way it is a bit of an experiment to see if such an event is possible. Please keep in mind that this is not a 'retreat centre'. It is a rural life-style block area and we want to run the retreat in a way that is considerate to our neighbour's daily lives; work, play, kids catching the school bus etc. We have a good ongoing relationship with our neighbours and we don't want this retreat to feel disruptive to them in any way. Generally there will be one class per day. The rest of the time, people will return to their place of accommodation to practice/explore/meditate on their own.

- 1) food, accommodation and transport (This will depend on what arrangements you have made) and,
- 2) dana for Tarchin
